3. Update from Ward Councillors

4. Matters arising from the minutes.

- Trees and branches were reported on Abbes Walk causing power lines to go out. Some trees look dead near Squirrel wood. As yet nothing has been sorted in this area.
- Fly Tipping – serious issues with fly tipping have been reported. These are reported regularly on Scorcher Hills Lane & Abbes Walk. Gas cannister dumping is still a problem. What3words is now Doncaster Council preferred way of reporting. Councillor Grimes has reported Gas canister dumped 3 times but still not removed.
